

Instructions for using a 134a Economy Charging Gauge Kit

As per use with any <u>flammable substance</u>, take adequate precautions during use.

- 1. Remove gauge from packaging.
- 2. With gauge in hand, turn T-handle up so the piercing valve is raised high enough that the piercing pin will not pierce the can.
- 3. Pick up can of product and connect can to the gauge end (this is the end of the hose with threads on the bottom of the T-handle).
- 4. After removing the cap from the A/C unit, connect the other end onto the low pressure port of the A/C by raising the black ring and snapping the coupler on to the fitting. This gauge will only connect to the low pressure side. If you cannot get the snap coupler to connect to the A/C, you are looking at the wrong port.
- 5. With the A/C system operating, check the pressure.
- 6. If the pressure is below the automobile manufacturer's specifications, turn the T-handle down to pierce the can. **Install refrigerant as per manufacturer's specifications.**
- 7. Turn the T-handle up to inject product into the system.
- 8. When the A/C unit is filled to the proper pressure, shut off the gauge by turning down the T-handle and remove the gauge from the system.
- 9. Replace the cap back onto the low pressure port.
